

PAYING YOUR TAXES

SELF ASSESSMENT – INCOME TAX

WHEN 31 January and 31 July (if you make payments on account)

HOW

- **Debit card** online <u>https://www.tax.service.gov.uk/pay-online/self-assessment</u> You will need your 10 digit tax reference (UTR) followed by 'K' as a payment reference
- **Bank transfer or telephone banking** to Sort Code 08 32 10 Account Number 12001039 Account Name HMRC Cumbernauld. You will need your 10 digit tax reference (UTR) followed by 'K' as a payment reference
- At your **bank or building society** if you have a paper statement and paying in slip from HMRC
- By **Direct Debit** if you have an online account with HMRC
- By **cheque** payable to 'HM Revenue & Customs only' followed by your UTR number through the post by writing to

HMRC Direct BX5 5BD

• Through **PAYE** if you owe less than £3,000 and you submit your paper return before 31 October or you file online before 30 December

CORPORATION TAX

WHEN 9 months and 1 day from the end of the accounting period – this is usually the same as the financial year end, but if your financial year is more than 365 days then you will have two payment dates.

Companies with profits over £1.5m pay in instalments

HOW

- **Debit card** online <u>https://www.tax.service.gov.uk/pay-online/corporation-tax</u> You will need your 17 digit payslip reference which is sent annually by HMRC
- Bank transfer or telephone banking to Sort Code 08 32 10 Account Number 12001039 Account Name HMRC Cumbernauld. You will need your 17 digit payslip reference which is sent annually by HMRC
- At your **bank or building society** using the payslip which is sent annually by HMRC
- By **Direct Debit** if you have an online account with HMRC

VAT

WHEN On the filing deadline - usually 1 month and 7 days following the end of the VAT quarter. So if your VAT return quarter end is 31 March then the deadline is 7 May for filing and paying.



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HOW

- **Debit card** online <u>https://www.tax.service.gov.uk/pay-online/vat</u> You will need your 9 digit VAT registration number
- **Bank transfer or telephone banking** to Sort Code 08 32 10 Account Number 11963155 Account Name HMRC VAT. You will need your 9 digit VAT number as a payment reference
- At your **bank or building society** if you order paying in slips from HMRC
- By Direct Debit via your VAT online account with HMRC

PAYE

WHEN

- If you pay monthly, 22nd of the month following the end of the tax month (see below)
- If you pay quarterly, 22nd of the month following the end of the tax quarter (see below)

HOW

- **Debit card** online <u>https://www.tax.service.gov.uk/pay-online/epaye</u> You will need your 13 digit Accounts Office number
- Bank transfer or telephone banking to Sort Code 08 32 10 Account Number 12001039 Account Name HMRC Cumbernauld. You will need your 13 digit Accounts Office reference number as a payment reference
- At your **bank or building society** using HMRC's payment booklet. Make cheques payable to 'HM Revenue & Customs only' followed by your 13 digit Accounts Office number reference
- By Direct Debit via your online account with HMRC

Tax Months are

Month 1	6 th April to 5 th May - Pay by 22 nd May
Month 2	6 th May to 5 th June - Pay by 22 nd June
Month 3	6 th June to 5 th July - Pay by 22 nd July
Month 4	6 th July to 5 th August- Pay by 22 nd August
Month 5	6 th August to 5 th September - Pay by 22 nd September
Month 6	6 th September to 5 th October- Pay by 22 nd October
Month 7	6 th October to 5 th November - Pay by 22 nd November
Month 8	6 th November to 5 th December - Pay by 22 nd December
Month 9	6 th December to 5 th January - Pay by 22 nd January
Month 10	6 th January to 5 th February - Pay by 22 nd February
Month 11	6 th February to 5 th March - Pay by 22 nd March
Month 12	6 th March to 5 th April - Pay by 22 nd April



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Tax Quarters

- Quarter 1 6th April to 5th July Pay by 22nd July
- Quarter 2 6th July to 5th October- Pay by 22nd October
- Quarter 3 6th October to 5th January Pay by 22nd January
- Quarter 4 6th January to 5th April Pay by 22nd April

Note that if you pay by cheque then HMRC must receive the cheque by 19th not 22nd
